



PUBLIC HEARING

AMENDMENT TO THE REGULATION TO ESTABLISH THE REQUIREMENT OF PRESENTING AN ORAL EXAMINATION CERTIFICATE TO BE ENROLLED IN A PUBLIC OR PRIVATE SCHOOL

By virtue of Act No. 63 of August 3, 2017, as well as Act No. 38 of June 30, 2017, known as the “Uniform Administrative Procedure Act of the Government of Puerto Rico”, and their respective organic laws, the Secretary of Health and the Secretary of Education propose to amend Regulation No. 9055 of November 6, 2018, *Regulation to establish the requirement to present an oral examination certificate to be enrolled in a public or private school*. The proposed amendment seeks to clarify the definition of oral examination and establish the suggested cost for issuing the oral health certificate, among other matters.
