



PUBLIC NOTICE

REGULATIONS TO ESTABLISH PREVENTIVE MEASURES FOR THE MANAGEMENT OF THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC AND ADMINISTRATIVE PENALTIES FOR NON-COMPLIANCE

Pursuant to the powers and authorities conferred by Act No. 81 of March 14, 1912, the Secretary of Health proposes to repeal Regulation 9210 of August 21, 2020, and to enact new Regulations to establish preventive measures for the management of the covid-19 pandemic and administrative penalties for noncompliance therewith. The proposed regulation is intended to establish the measures of the Department of Health for the protection of public health due to the emergency caused by COVID-19 and establishes the corresponding penalties for noncompliance with such measures.
