



PUBLIC HEARING

REGULATION OF THE SECRETARY OF HEALTH ON THE IMMUNIZATION REGISTRY OF PUERTO RICO

Pursuant to the powers and authorities conferred by Act No. 81 of March 14, 1912, as amended, known as the “Organic Law of the Department of Health, Act No. 169 of December 12, 2019, known as the Registry Law of Immunization of Puerto Rico and Act No. 38 of June 30, 2017, known as the “Uniform Administrative Procedures Act of the Government of Puerto Rico”, it is proposed to adopt the ***“Regulation of the Secretary of the Department of Health on the Registry of Immunization of Puerto Rico”***.

The purpose of adopting this regulation is to establish the rules and procedures necessary to regulate matters related to the registration of vaccines administered in Puerto Rico. The proposed regulation is published on the Department of Health website www.salud.gov.pr.
