PUBLIC HEARING

REGULATIONS OF THE CENTER FOR THE COORDINATION OF SERVICES FOR PERSONS WITH ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE

Pursuant to Act No. 13-1998, known as the Center for the Coordination of Services for Persons Affected with Alzheimer's Disease in Puerto Rico Act and Act No. 38-2017, known as the Uniform Administrative Procedure Act of the Government of Puerto Rico, the Secretary of Health intends to repeal Regulation No. 6913 of December 14, 2004, and adopt a new Regulation of the Center for the Coordination of Services for Persons with Alzheimer's Disease. The purpose of the proposed regulations is to comply with and advance the public policy outlined by the Department, in addition to renewing and improving the services offered to the population that has been impacted by Alzheimer's disease.
