

PUBLIC HEARING

REGULATIONS FOR THE ISSUANCE OF IDENTIFICATION CARDS TO SENIOR CITIZENS AND PERSONS WITH FUNCTIONAL DIVERSITY

Pursuant to Act No. 108 of July 12, 1985, Act No. 107 of July 3, 1998, as well as Act No. 38-2017, known as the Uniform Administrative Procedure Act of the Government of Puerto Rico, the Secretary of Health intends to repeal Regulation 6143 of May 8, 2000, and adopt a new Regulation for the Issuance of Identification Cards to Senior Citizens and Persons with Disabilities. The proposed regulation is intended to modernize and clarify the procedure for the elderly and persons with functional diversity to obtain their identification card for the enjoyment of the rights granted by law.
