

PUBLIC HEARING

REGULATION FOR PROVIDERS OF CONTINUING EDUCATION TO PHYSICIANS AND HEALTH PROFESSIONALS LICENSED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH

Pursuant to Act No. 81 of March 14, 1912, as amended, known as the Department of Health Act, Act No. 11 of June 23, 1976, as well as Act No. 38-2017, known as the Uniform Administrative Procedure Act of the Government of Puerto Rico, the Secretary of Health proposes to adopt the Regulations for Providers of Continuing Education to Physicians and Health Professionals Licensed by the Department of Health. The proposed regulations establish the requirements to be authorized by the Division of Licensing of Physicians and Health Professionals as a provider of continuing education for health professionals.
